- 5) ASHA/ASHA Supervisor needs to Counsel the couple on various benefits of spacing and limiting.
- 6) The Male & Female Sterilization Camp Schedule should be prepared covering all BPHC's and U/C, in the March for better (FP) performance.
- 7) An overview of total Male & Female Sterilization performance, failure, complication, death and claims has been discussed by the joint Director of Health services, Jorhat.
