

## **Minutes of the meeting of District Quality Assurance Committee**

The meeting started with welcome address by the Joint Director of Health Services, Karimganj.

The following points have been discussed:

1. **Discussion and Review of FP Services in the District:** The The committee was appraised about the PF performance. After threadbare discussion, the committee requested the Gynecologists from Civil Hospital to focus on the PAFP Services especially sterilization and PAIUCD. It also decided that for incentive claims especially for FP services be cleared at the earliest and BAM/RMNCH Counselor is directed to expedite the claim process for both the beneficiaries as well as for the service providers,
2. **Action Plan for Lap. Sterilization Camp:** The committee is appraised about the number of camps being conducted by the peripheral institutions. It has been reported that the institutions after finalising camps decide to cancel at the eleventh hour for which the performance goes down and it has been decided that once a camp schedule is finalized, the BPHCs/concerned institutions be advised not to cancel those camps. Further, the DFPC is directed to prepare an action plan in consultation with the Surgeons and the same be shared with the BPHCs. After that a camp schedule is to be finalized and circulated with all the stake holders.


#### **It has been decided that**

- a) As the Family Planning performance of our district is very poor, it is hereby directed to put maximum efforts to make the camp successful.
  - b) If the norms of 30 cases/camp is not fulfilled, the expenditure incurred may be managed from the RKS fund of the respective institutions as per resolution of the DISC meeting held on 05-01-2018.
  - c) The camp schedule is prepared after due discussion with the managerial staff of the concerned institutions. Hence, it is requested that cancellation of the scheduled camp should not be done for silly reasons.
3. **Discussion on Accreditation of Makunda Christian Leprosy & General Hospital (MCLGH), Bazaricherra:** The Committee decided that as the MCLGH is equipped to provide PPS services, the institution may be visited for an insight knowledge and feasibility of services. The Addl. Chief Medical & Health Officer (FW) along with

DPMU and BPMU members may conduct a spot verification to ascertain the status for further process. A mechanism may be devised to pass on the benefits to the beneficiaries of Karimganj district.


4. **Discussion on Sterilization Failure Claims:** The committee discussed about the failure claims. Three cases have been scrutinized and the committee decided to submit the claims to higher authorities.
