Deputy Commissioner Health Lakhimpur Sri Mouchumi Baruah, ACS and the chairman addressed the participants with a welcome note on importance of the quality processes in Health Sector. The Jt. DHS initiated the discussions as per agenda and the following points were discussed and minuted –

- a.) The Committee members decided to review the working committee in NL Civil Hospital and found that the DQAT NLCH notified earlier needs some minor changes as the unavailability of the Hospital Administrator at NLCH will be a hindrance for the DQAT to function properly. The Superintendent requested the Jt. DHS to nominate a person against the vacant post of HA NLCH so that the DQAT can function and major action points which were identified and requires continuous follow up, can be addressed on regular basis.
- b.) The Committee discussed regarding the scores of NLCH as per previous assessment and requested the Superintendent NLCH to circulate the identified gaps as per the assessment report to all concerned stakeholders.
- c.) The Committee discussed regarding development of SOP s and Standard Policies as per mandates of the NQAS and decided to activate DQAT members to in their concerned areas for the same.
- d.) The Superintendent NLCH also mentioned regarding the initiative taken for staff orientation during Kayakalp activities.
- e.) The DISC members present in the meeting raised the matter regarding quality aspects in fixed day statics and reasons of failure cases. The BPMUs are given responsibility for proper case counseling for successful camps.



Chairman decided to hold the next meeting after one month to review the progress of the NQAS activities. Meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
