- The subject matter of the meeting is to re-constitution of District Indemity Sub-Committee (DISC) under District Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC) to evaluate the quality that to be ensured during sterilization (both female laparoscopic and NSV).
- He emphasized that the facility registers and client records needs to be reviewed
 frequently to check if record keeping is being done correctly and properly. It
 should be ensured that these registers and records contain information pertaining
 to the demographic details of the clients, informed consent, complete medical
 examination, in short both Annexure II & Annexure III has to be filled properly.
- Joint Director of Health services, Tinsukia has more emphasized on both technical (viz, to maintain clinical protocol, infection control, emergency response etc.) and service quality (prompt service delivery, courteous behavior of staff and hygiene and cleanliness and privacy and dignity).
- It is to be ensured that for uninterrupted supply of family planning commodities close monitoring of FP-LMIS portal upto block level much needed.
- Moreover it is to be ensured that follow-up of sterilization cases (both male and female) and it should be the regular practices of ASHAs and ASHA Supervisor.

- An overview of total family planning performance, failure, complications, death and claim has been discussed by the Joint Director of Health services, Tinsukia and he satisfied the efforts given by family planning division in each category.
