You are requested to reimburse mobile bills of ASHAs @Rs. 100/- per ASHA per month as per guidelines mentioned below.

## Guidelines:

- 1. ASHA will claim mobile reimbursement @Rs. 100/- per month along with other incentives.
- 2. Reimbursement should be made to active ASHAs only.
- 3. If one ASHA don't claim any activity other than routine activities, then reimbursement for mobile shall not be made for that month for that particular ASHA.
- 4. Phone number of ASHAs must be reflected in the RCH portal. Phone number of ASHAs should be verified and validated in the RCH portal.
- 5. Phone number of ASHAs should be provided to all eligible couple, pregnant women, parent of children and all health officials.
- 6. ASHA can take mobile connection and any tariff plan from any Telecom service provider as per need. It is suggested to continue with the existing mobile number.
- 7. If any ASHA changes her mobile number, then that should be immediately informed to the concerned Health Block and phone number should be modified, verified and validated in the RCH portal.
- 8. As per criteria mentioned in the approval part of RoP 2022-24,
  - Entry of validated mobile number of minimum 60% beneficiaries should be ensured in the RCH portal.
  - Registration of more than 60% beneficiary (eligible couple, pregnant women and children) must be ensured on pro-rata basis.

- Delivery of due services to more than 50% beneficiaries (mother & child) on pro-rata basis and its updation on RCH portal should be ensured.
- Continuation/ extension of the activity would be based on improvement in registration of pregnant women and children and data of service delivery and availability of updated and validated information related to ANM, ASHAs, Urban ASHAs and beneficiaries on RCH portal.
- 9. Total expenditure should not exceed the total amount allocated against the district.
- 10. Expenditure should be booked under FMR code HSS.12 195.10 for the FY 2023-24.

This is for favour of information and necessary action.
