

Minutes of the meeting of District Indemnity Sub-committee (2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2022-23)

Venue: O/O the Joint Director of Health Services, Karimganj. Date: 29<sup>th</sup> Aug'2022. Time: 2.00 PM.

The meeting started with welcome address by the Joint Director of Health Services, Karimganj.

The following points have been discussed and decisions have been taken:

**1. Analysis of FP Performance:** The committee analysed the FP performance comparing with that of the last year and decided that the District Hospital should put maximum efforts to gear up performance.

**PPIUCD:** It is decided that for PPIUCD, all delivery points wherein trained manpower is there, the ideal target is 25% of delivery and at least 20% PPIUCD should be inserted. 1 batch of CHOs have been trained in the last financial year and those who are non-performers are to be ore-oriented at respective BPHC headquarters to enable them to perform.

**PAIUCD:** PAIUCD performance of the district is very poor. The committee decided that CAC trained MOs should insert maximum PAIUCD & no beneficiary should be left without contraception.


**IUCD:** IUCD will be conducted as usual by the BPHCs/HIs/SCs on regular as well as on camp mode. The BPHCs may conduct camps individually or by clubbing one or two SCs The performance will be included against the respective institutions. The committee is appraised that regarding camp management, both LS & IUCD, a separate letter had already been issued to BPHCs to ensure the fund is directly credited to the HIs conducting the camps.

**Antara:** As the Antara performance is declining gradually, the committee decided that to minimise drop out, the Health Workers (SN/ANM/MPW/ASHAs) should counsel properly during 1<sup>st</sup> dose. It has been found that due to alteration in menstrual cycle, the beneficiaries got scared and not visit for subsequent doses which is the result of poor counseling.

**2.Lap Sterilisation Camps & Schedule:** The committee is appraised that there is only one LS surgeon available in the district at present & in all sites camps could not be conducted. It is decided that two more LS surgeons need to be given Training for which nominations have already been sent to state HQ and the training schedule will be communicated shortly. Dr Taher Ahmed Choudhury, and Dr Niladri Shekhar Das is suggested for training.

**3. FPLMIS:** The committee decided that to smoothen operation of FPLMIS, in all meetings, FPLMIS is to be included in agenda points. Frequent orientation is to be given to health workers especially ANMs and ASHAs. Further, all pharmacists are given the responsibility to look after the operation of FPLMIS. The S.D.M. & H.O, and I/Cs of all health institutions should monitor the FPLMIS regularly. All non-functioning Service Delivery Points (SDPs), SCs and ASHAs are to be activated.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.


