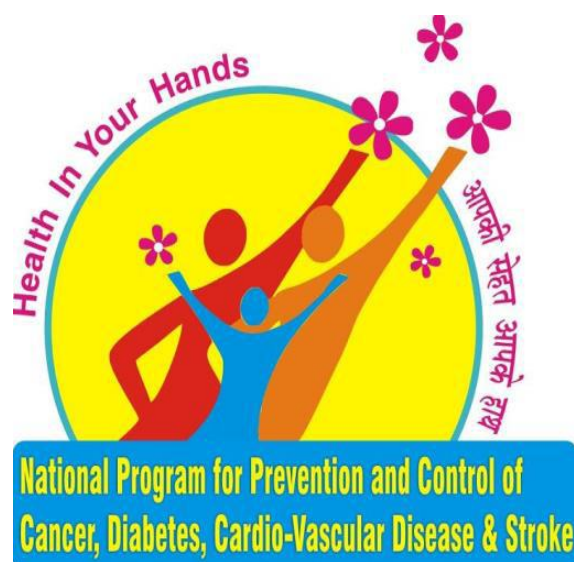

Preface

In India, the estimated deaths due to NCDs in 2008 were 5.3 million (World Health Organization - NCD Country Profiles, 2011). The overall prevalence of diabetes, hypertension, Ischemic Heart Diseases (IHD) and stroke in India is 62.47, 159.46, 37.00 and 1.54 respectively per 1000 population. (Indian council for Medical Research, 2006) which showed for need of NCD intervention. The integration of Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) intervention with NHM has done in the FY 2012-13 so that optimization of scarce resources and provision of seamless services to the patients as also for ensuring long term sustainability of interventions. Objective of the programme is as below:

1. Health promotion through behaviour change with involvement of community, civil society, community based organizations, media etc.
2. Opportunistic screening at all levels in the health care delivery system from sub-centre and above for early detection of diabetes, hypertension and common cancers. Outreach camps are also envisaged.
3. To prevent and control chronic Non-Communicable diseases, especially Cancer, Diabetes, CVDs and Stroke.
4. To build capacity at various levels of health care for prevention, early diagnosis, treatment, IEC/BCC, operational research and rehabilitation.
5. To support for diagnosis and cost effective treatment at primary, secondary and tertiary levels of health care.
6. To support for development of database of NCDs through Surveillance System and to monitor NCD morbidity and mortality and risk factors.

To achieve above mentioned objective the “**District NCD Cell**” is been established in every districts to ensure implementation and supervision of the programme activities related to health promotion, early diagnosis, treatment, referral, and follow up of NCDs. The **District NCD Clinic**, and **CHC NCD Clinic** has been established to provide clinical services related to NCDs in all districts. Also to cater critical cases of NCDs for eg Stroke, COPD, Asthma, seven “**Critical Care Unit (CCUs)**” is been established in Dibrugarh, Jorhat, Lakhimpur, Sivasagar, Nagoan, Kamrup (R) and Dhumri districts.

Key priority areas for 2019-20 under NPCDCS:

1. To make **District NCD Clinic fully functional:**
 - i. Opportunistic screening of HTN, DM, Oral cancer, Breast cancer and Cervical cancer
 - ii. Management of referral cases of NCDs from CHC NCD Clinic/CHC/PHC-HWC/PHC
 - iii. Refer back of treated and managed patient to the respective health facilities for follow up
 - iv. Referral of seriously ill patient with NPCDCS referral slip to tertiary care/higher center for treatment
 - v. Maintain all records and reporting to the District NCD Cell as per NPCDCS guidelines
2. To make **CHC NCD Clinic fully functional:**
 - i. Opportunistic screening of HTN, DM, Oral cancer, Breast cancer and Cervical cancer
 - ii. Management of referral cases of NCDs from PHC-HWC/PHC/SC-HWC/SC
 - iii. Refer back of treated and managed patient to the respective health facilities for follow up
 - iv. Referral of seriously ill patient with NPCDCS referral slip to tertiary care/higher center for treatment
 - v. Maintain all records and reporting to the District NCD Cell as per NPCDCS guidelines

3. To make **Cardiac Care Unit fully functional:**

- i. Management of Stroke, acute cardiac illness, Myocardial Infraction, COPD, Asthma, complicated cases of HTN and DM cases should be done in the CCUs.
 - ii. The CCU facility should also be utilized for the management of other emergency medical cases like burn, trauma, poisoning, drowning etc.
 - iii. Referral to nearest tertiary care facilities (Medical College hospital) of those cases who could not be managed at the facility.
 - iv. Maintain all records and reporting to the District NCD Cell as per NPCDCS guidelines.
4. Opportunistic screening, management and reporting of HTN and DM in all health facilities i.e MPHC, PHC, CHC, Model Hospital and SDH. Also, referral of seriously ill NCD patient with NPCDCS referral slip to nearest CHC NCD Clinic/District NCD Clinic.
5. Adherence of opportunistic screening services in all **Sub-Centers** for opportunistic screening of HTN and DM and reporting for the same to their concern BPHC. Referral of suspected cases with NPCDCS referral slip to nearest health facility for their diagnosis and treatment.

Conditionalities Framework of RoP – 2019-20, which are to be adhered to:

The conditionalities mentioned below are to be adhered to so that state can achieve the given target and thus state earns incentive instead of dis-incentive from MoHFW, GoI.

Conditionality No 1: This conditionality is linked to % of 30 plus population screened for NCDs. If

1. 15% of the 30 plus population is screened for NCDs then 5 points incentive would be given;
2. 7% of the 30 plus population is screened for NCDs then 3 points incentive would be given;
3. Less than 3% of 30 plus population screened for NCDs then 3 points penalty;
4. Less than 2% of 30 plus population screened for NCDs then 5 points penalty;
5. 50% of the screening data must be captured in NCD App (denominator will be total 30 plus population of the district);

Data source for verification of conditionality performances would be State Report / NHSRC Report / NCD Division Report of MoHFW, GoI or any survey data report.

F.M. R. Owner- a) State Level: SPO (NCD), FLC (NCD)

b) Dist. Level: Superintendent of District Hospital

Guideline for the activity:

1. The fund under this FMR is allocated to all 27 districts for mobility, miscellaneous and contingency of the District NCD Clinic. In the district where infrastructure work of District NCD clinic is not completed, the Superintendent of the hospital will earmark a OPD as District NCD Clinic.
2. As there is no programme specific Medical Officer, the Medical Superintendent will designate one Medical Officer as in-charge of the District NCD Clinic and two Staff Nurses from the district hospital for smooth functioning of District NCD Clinic.
3. There is an approval of one Data Entry Operator cum record keeper in every District NCD Clinic and the information related to same will be shared soon from the State HQ.
4. **Activities of District NCD Clinic:**
 - a) Promotion of District NCD Clinic i.e. departmental signage, designation signage, list of services available in the clinic etc. in the respective District hospital
 - b) The District NCD Clinic will do opportunistic screening for NCDs i.e HTN, DM, Oral, Breast and Cervical Cancer to all the patient coming directly to the clinic. Also treatment and management will be done for HTN and DM cases in the facility. For cancer suspected cases referral will be done with NPCDCS referral slip to the nearest Medical College Hospital.
 - c) The Districts NCD Clinic will be interlinked with all other OPDs of the district hospital. All suspected/diagnosed NCD patients examined in other OPDs will be sent to the District NCD Clinic for further evaluation, confirmation, follow up and continuum of care where their records will be maintained as per NPCDCS guideline.
 - d) The Districts NCD Clinic will cater all the referred NCD patients from the SC-Health and Wellness Centers, PHC-HWC, CHC NCD Clinic, SDH and any other health facilities.
 - e) All those patients treated and managed at the District NCD Clinic, will be refer back with referral advice to the Health Facility which is close to the residence of the Patient for the continuum of care.
 - f) Once the diagnosis of Hypertension/ Diabetes is established in District NCD clinic, the patient must receive at least a month's supply of drugs from the clinic/Hospital.
 - g) The NCD patients who require referral to higher centres, will be referred to the nearest Medical college/ Tertiary care Hospital (Govt.) with NPCDCS referral slip and records will be maintained in the referral register.
5. **The fund under this FMR will be utilized for below mentioned miscellaneous and contingency activities:**
 - a. Ensuring availability and functionality of all equipment's and consumables required for smooth functioning of the District NCD Clinic – BP Machine, Stethoscope, weighing machine, Glucometer (with gluco strips and lancet), Nebulizer, wooden spatula, torch light, disposable gloves, x-ray view box, cusco speculum, focus light, Acetic acid etc.
 - b. Ensuring availability of all necessary arrangements like examination stool, examination screen, curtains etc for maintaining comfort and privacy of the patient during examination.
 - c. For Departmental signage, designation signage etc for District NCD Clinic.
 - d. Office stationaries for record keeping – NPCDCS registers, reporting forms, referral registers, referral slips etc.
 - e. Any other activities required for smooth functioning of the District NCD Clinic.

1. The fund under this FMR is allocated for 178 CHC NCD Clinic from all 27 districts for mobility, miscellaneous and contingency.
2. The districts will designate one OPD in every CHC (including Model hospitals) as a CHC NCD clinic.
3. As there is no programme specific Medical Officer, the CHC/Model Hospital in-charge will designate one Medical Officer as in-charge of the CHC NCD Clinic and one Staff Nurses from the respective CHC/Model Hospital for smooth functioning of CHC NCD Clinic.

4. Activities of CHC NCD Clinic:

- a) Promotion of CHC NCD Clinic i.e. departmental signage, designation signage, list of services available in the clinic etc. in the respective CHC/Model Hospital
- b) The CHC NCD Clinic will do opportunistic screening for NCDs i.e HTN, DM, Oral, Breast and Cervical Cancer to all the patient coming directly to the clinic. Also treatment and management will be done for HTN and DM cases in the facility. For cancer suspected cases referral will be done with NPCDCS referral slip to the nearest Medical College Hospital.
- c) The CHC NCD Clinic will be interlinked with all other OPDs of the CHC/Model Hospital. All suspected/diagnosed NCD patients examined in other OPDs will be sent to the CHC NCD Clinic for further evaluation, confirmation, follow up and continuum of care where their records will be maintained as per NPCDCS guideline.
- d) The CHC NCD Clinic will cater all the referred NCD patients from the SC-Health and Wellness Centers, PHC-HWC, PHC and any other health facilities.

- h) The NCD patients who require referral to higher centres, will be referred to the nearest District NCD Clinic/Medical college/ Tertiary care Hospital (Govt.) with NPCDCS referral slip and records will be maintained in the referral register.

5. The fund under this FMR will be utilized for below mentioned miscellaneous and contingency activities:

- a. - 2 MO i/c along with other block officials of every block BPHC will closely monitor the activities and progress of NCD programme including HWCs under his/her jurisdiction.
- 3 The MO i/c of every Block PHC will visit the Health and Wellness Centers in the block at least once in every month and maintain records of all monitoring activity in the form of reports and action taken reports for evaluation. Monitoring checklist for the HWC will be provided by State soon.
- 4 For monitoring if officers (MO, BPM, BCM) use hired vehicle, the rate has to be approved by the District Health Society or approved rate in NHM Assam.

Guideline for the activity:

1. Funds under this FMR allocated to all 27 districts will be utilized for procurement of drugs for NCD.
2. Every District NCD Clinic will have drugs (as per NPCDCS drugs list) listed in EDL for the management of emergency cases of NCD for eg. Severe Hypertension, Hypoglycemia, Hyperglycemia, Diabetic Ketoacidosis, Stroke, Myocardial Infarction, COPD etc.
3. In case of non-availability of drugs(as per NPCDCS drug list)which is listed in EDL, district will procure and make them available in the District NCD Clinic (Drugs list under NPCDCS enclosed in Annexure-1 and for EDL List kindly refer NHM Assam website).
4. After stock assessment and estimation of required quantity of drugs procurement will be done by the "District committee for procurement "following all the financial norms/procedures under NHM Assam.

5. During estimation of required drugs kindly note that the patient must receive at least a month's supply of drugs from the clinic/Hospital for their diagnosis of Hypertension/ Diabetes is in District NCD clinic.
