Preface

The National Health Mission (NHM) strives to provide health care services on Mental Health to all the citizens of the State in an equitable manner through the National Mental Health Programme (NMHP). The main objectives of the programme is to provide mental health services including prevention, promotion and long- term continuing care at different levels of healthcare delivery system, to augment institutional capacity interms of infrastructure, equipment and human resource for mental health care, to promote community awareness and participation in the delivery of mental health care services, to broad- base mental health into other related health programmes.

The strategy of NMHP is to integrate mental healthserevices with primary health care, provision of tertiary care institutions for treatment of mental disorders and eradicating stigmatization of mentally ill patients and protecting their rights through regulatory institutions like the Central Mental Health Authority and State Mental health Authority.

Components included in this programme are a.Service provision: Management of cases of mental disorders in both OPD and IPD, counseling at healthcare delivery system and providing the essential psychiatric drugs, b. Targeted intervention camps: District level screening cum intervention camps in the community including schools, colleges, offices, slum areas, out of schools, jails, NGOs, Stress management workshops at workplaces, Camps on suicide prevention in the community/ Depression clinics etc., c.Capacity building: Manpower training on mental health to the MOs, Staff Nurses, Paramedical workers, 108 & 102 drivers & technicians, police personnels, Jail Doctors, Persons from Social Welfare department, Govt. officials, Magistrates and NGO workers for mentally ill patient and development for prevention, early identification and management of mental disorders, **d.Awareness generation:** through IEC activities for early identification of mental disorders so that timely management of such cases is possible as well as for removal of stigma attached to Mental illness.

This operational guideline is intended to support the efforts of the districts in ensuring a smooth and successful functioning of District Mental Health Programme (DMHP) under National Mental Health Programme (NMHP) of health facilities.

<u>About the activity:</u> Under NMHP- District Mental Health Programme: Targeted intervention includes the following activities:

- i. Awareness about mental health, features of mental disorders, availability of their management
- ii. Screening for depression, psychosis, anxiety etc.
- iii. Pharmacotherapy as per need
- iv. Counselling as per need
- v. Referral as per need

Under NMHP- State HQ: Targeted Intervention activities in Government Offices & Colleges/Universities regarding Mental Health, work life balance, stigma regarding mental illness etc.

<u>Aim</u>: To sensitize the whole community about mental health, features of mental disorders, screening of mental health disorders among the population, availability of their management in the PHCs/CHCs/District Hospitals and benefits of treatment.

Expenditure can be incurred on the following activity:

- 1. Targeted intervention about mental health, features of mental disorders, availability of their management in the BPHCs/MPHCs/SDs/UPHCs etc.
- 2. Targeted intervention about mental health, features of mental disorders, availability of their management in **schools.**
- 3. Targeted intervention camps aboutSuicide prevention/Depression at Community Health Centres (CHCs).
- 4. Targeted interventions about mental health, features of mental disorders, availability of their management and stress management in the **jail once in a month (every month in the same time).**

5. Targeted interventions about mental health, features of mental disorders, availability of their management and stress management at NGOs working for mentally ill persons (Twice in a month to each NGO).

Note:

- > Before each Targeted Intervention camp the following points should be ensured:
 - i. Pre camp awareness regarding the visit in the respective area. To be taken in collaboration with the incharge of that facility and local ASHA. So that, maximum benificiaries can avail the services.
 - Banners & posters should be used adequately and placed properly. ii.
 - iii. Ensure checklist- 1. Drugs, 2. Register, 3. TA/DA or Honorarium form (whichever is applicable).
 - Topics on danger signs of impending selfharm/suicide and suicide prevention, stress iv. management, mental wellness, Tele- MANAS (14416) and DMHP services should be mandatorily covered in the awareness talks.
- > While making action plan for targeted intervention camps it should be made sure that a place is visited at the same date of the quarter/month with prior information to increase the number of benificiaries.
- > The camps given for the **FY 2023-24**, at CHCs/BPHCs/MPHCs/SDs/UPHCs etc. needs to be repeated in quarterly basis so that total 4 visits (in one block) can be made in the year. The lists of Health Institutions are attached as Annexure-II.
- > Action plan for each quarter needs to be submitted in an advance way to the State HQ on or before 3rd day of the first month.
- > A format has been attached as Annexure- I to be recorded in register for each camp and a scan copy to be submitted to the State HQ along with the monthly report.
- > During the visit to the NGO, a survey needs to be done as per the Mental Healthcare Act and Rules and report shall be submitted to the State cell with monthly report.
- Average number of camps will be **<u>7-8 per month</u>**. The clinical Psychologist shall take active part in camps conducted in schools and colleges and shall visit the schools and colleges as and when required.
- > It is necessary to take support of Deputy Commissioner and Joint Director of Health Services concerned to organize the targeted intervention cum screening camps at workplaces.
- > The amount provided in the budget for travel is tentative amount and in case it is not sufficient for the same the DMHP team may utilize the amount given under the FMR code: NCD.2 (Sl. No.- 97.11) which is given for miscellaneous/travel/contingency.
