PREFACE

National Oral Health Programme (NOHP) was initiated by Govt. of India to provide integrated comprehensive oral health services in the existing health care facilities. Presently, implementation of NOHP is taken up in 34 districts which include 108 health institutions across the State. The programme aims to improve the provision of dental care along with other ongoing health programmes in the District hospital and below. For this purpose dental units at district level or below are being established. This unit consists of Manpower (Dental Surgeon, Dental Hygienist (presently nonexistent), Dental Assistant.), Equipment, Consumables etc.

The State Nodal Officer and Addl. State Nodal officer are in-charge of NOHP cell at the State level. The District Oral Health Cell are headed by designated District Nodal Officer (DNO). They shall work in coordination with other umbrella programmes as relevant.

Objectives of the programme include the following:

- 1. Improvement in the determinants of oral health (IEC/BCC).
- 2. Reduce morbidity from oral diseases by strengthening Oral Health services at District/Sub Division/CHC hospital (HR, Consumables, Equipment, Infrastructure) and
- 3. Integrate Oral Health Promotion and preventive services with other system that influence oral health (NTCP, RBSK, NPPCF, NCD etc.)

The main focus in the FY, 2024-26 have the following component:

- 1. Development for prevention and early identification and management of Oral Health.
- 2. Service provision including Dental OPD, Extraction, minor surgeries, root canal treatment, oral prophylaxis, provision of Dentures (RPD, CD), restorations, pit & fissure sealant, treatment of precancerous patients, case referring to higher centres etc.
- 3. Dental Consumables for all Dental Care Unit.
- 4. Awareness generation through IEC activities for early identification of oral health problems, especially children so that timely management of cases is possible.

With this background the District RoP for the FY 2024-26 under NOHP is prepared.
