Prevent Rabies

Safeguarding yourself and your loved ones is of utmost importance, and taking proactive measures can significantly reduce the chances of rabies.

Do's in case of a dog bite

- Immediately wash the wound thoroughly with soap and running water for a minimum of 15 minutes
- Apply antiseptic
- Contact a doctor or visit a health institution for treatment immediately
- Complete Anti Rabies Vaccination course as advised by your Doctor
- Ensure your domestic dog is vaccinated against rabies

Don'ts in case of a dog bite

- Do not ignore licks/scratches/ wounds caused by animals
- Do not believe in superstitions
- Do not pack or stitch the wound
- Do not ignore immediate cleaning of wound
