Welcoming all Participants Dr. Mukul Ch. Das Joint Director, Health Services said that the committee's meeting is needed to solve the problems arises on run of F.P Services in the District. All the members have a great role for smooth full activities of F.P. Services. The committee should take decision for empanelment of surgeons for Sterilization and NSV which is highly needed in the district.

Reviewing the FP Performance of the district Mr. Ananta Gogoi, District Extension & Media Officer (FW), Sivasagar expressed that the district has not achieved a good performance in the last year as well as in this current year till date. The FP performance of the current year is going down due to shortage of surgeons in the district. Mobile sterilization camps could not be organized on time. In Patsaku BPHC, though the beneficiaries are available but due to the shortage of surgeons, most of the cases are still pending for laparoscopic sterilization. Therefore the DEMO requested suggestions from all the members of the committee to improve the performance. IUCD Performance is satisfactory in the current year. Training on IUCD, PPIUCD are running in the district.

Dr. R. Baruah, Superintendent, Sivasagar Civil has said that the shortage of required no of surgeons are the main cause of low performance. He also said that the camps should maintain the basic quality service in each and every OT. Dr. Sadhan Borah, Gynecologist, Sivasagar Civil Hospital said that special bed is a must for laparoscopic sterilization.

Dr. Mukul Ch. Das, Joint DHS, Sivasagar mentioned that Kalugaon BPHC and Gaurisagar BPHC refers the beneficiaries to the Sivasagar Civil Hospital therefore the performance of Sivasagar Civil goes up and the performance of the said BPHCs become very poor. The Jt. DHS also suggested to check the Boil Apparatus before delivering it to Amguri CHC.

Dr. Nirmal. Chutia, Supdt.-II, KHS Nazira, S.D.C.H suggested that to improve the NSV performance the MPWs should be involved and they should be trained for the awareness of the benefits of the NSV.

After various discussions the committee took the following decision in the meeting.

1. The Committee will visit the Domor Dollong TE Central Hospital for OT, Lap and NSV camp.
2. The Committee members will visit and monitor the laparoscopic camps in the district.


