ORDER

Whereas, with the increase in the number of COVID-19 tests being carried out, the number of COVID cases detected is increasing in different districts of Assam;

Whereas, some of the newly detected cases are found to be symptomatic and it has been experienced that there is rapid deterioration in some cases;

Whereas, immediate care including proper referral to a higher centre with all necessary precautions, is to be provided for such patients;


Whereas, a number of new COVID Care Centres (CCC) and dedicated COVID Hospitals are being established in the districts to cater to the increasing need for in-patient management of COVID positive patients,

Whereas, number of people opting to avail home isolation facility is also increasing;

Now, under the aforesaid circumstances, the Government in Health & Family Welfare Department hereby constitutes District Critical Care Coordination Committee (DCCC) for each district in the State, with the following members:

All the Medical Colleges (if located within the district) / District and other Hospitals / Private Hospitals / Nursing Homes in the district will come under the supervision of concerned District Critical Care Coordination Committee (DCCC) as far as the Covid-19 treatment is concerned.

The District Level Critical Care Coordination Committee shall be convened everyday with available members (other members through video conference if needed) to:

1. Analyse the situation of COVID patients in the district, hospital wise and area wise.
2. Monitor & ensure compliance with the COVID Care Centres (CCC) operational guidelines issued by NHM, Assam.
3. Institute a mechanism for obtaining regular feedback from patients.
4. Resolve any issues related to treatment, referral transport and coordination with different hospitals within the district (both Government and private) and also with the concerned Zonal Medical College for that district.
5. The DLCCC will create awareness about plasma donation from the eligible donors and also facilitate plasma donation in close coordination with the respective Zonal Medical Colleges.
6. Plan and prepare for enhanced testing in different areas of the districts with proper coordination with local community
7. Ensure availability of logistics and essential medicines in all COVID Care Centres and COVID Hospitals so that the patients receive treatment as per protocol and frontline health workers receive proper prophylaxis
8. Ensure that the biomedical waste generated during screening, testing, quarantine, and treatment in different locations are disposed off following all relevant guidelines
9. Discuss and resolve any other matter related to COVID Management.

The minutes of daily meetings shall be shared with all members on a daily basis and required instructions and guidelines will be sought from the appropriate authority as and when needed.
