Dear All D.Cs

You are aware that we have many distinguished persons residing in our state who have contributed immensely for bringing name and fame to the state in the field of arts/culture/literature/language/sports, etc. Further, many of them may be senior citizens with mobility issues and may be suffering from critical illness or may be having co-morbidities which might prevent them from getting vaccinated for Covid-19.

The District Administration must definitely be in know of such eminent persons residing in the district. In order to ensure vaccination on priority for them, you may like to prepare a micro plan to conduct a special drive for vaccination at their house premises of such persons who are limited in number.

For this purpose, the Joint DHS and Addl. CM&HO (FW) of all the districts shall arrange a Vehicle/Ambulance/Mobile Medical Unit to carry out the vaccination drive for this category of beneficiaries. Such vehicles should have all essential medical equipments and man power to manage and transport the beneficiary in case of any AEFI.

In order to avoid vaccination wastage, route map should be prepared and beneficiaries are to be bundled in multiples of ten or twenty.

In order to have a visible impact, this exercise is to be completed within the period from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2021. You may submit a weekly report in this regard to the undersigned and to Director of Health Services (FW), Assam. The ADC (In-charge) of vaccination should be asked to personally monitor this programme.
